The Challenge

Cancer Research UK required a high end IT service provider to assist with the disposal of redundant IT equipment from numerous locations throughout the UK.

This was due to Cancer Research UK's scientists requiring an IT refresh and the need for high-specification IT equipment to conduct complex research.

Cancer Research UK required the disposal of all redundant IT equipment to take place within a 1 month period.

It was critical to Cancer Research UK that they find an established company in IT asset disposal, which could take care of all their IT disposal requirements.

EOL IT Services Solution

Cancer Research UK turned to EOL IT Services, one of the UK's leading independent IT project management, data security and asset disposal companies.

Once at EOL's main site, EOL safely destroyed all Cancer Research UK's sensitive data via Blancco certified software, degaussing, crushing, shredding and/or granulation down to 6mm particle size. By using EOL, Cancer Research UK remained compliant with all UK and European legislation, including WEEE directives.
