

Langley School



Sitting only 95mm above the kerb, the Plateau Rooflight was the perfect solution for the contractor who didn't want the rooflights to be visible from the front of the building.

Langley School is homed in what was an 18th Century Grade 1 listed Mansion set in 110 acres of historic landscape in Norwich.

The Langley School estates team was briefed to develop what was once an open courtyard into a covered space, for use as an overspill area for dining facilities, assemblies, and events. This area had to be developed without lessening the impact of the beautiful Grade 1 listed historic setting.



Plateau Rooflights have been installed above the corridor area of the school allowing a large amount of natural light down into the corridor space.



The fine lines of the Plateau Rooflight create an aesthetically pleasing design, making it suitable for any flat roof construction.

“In designing the facility we needed to choose products and materials that would be practical yet sympathetic to the existing listed structure. We needed a rooflight that was appropriate for the historic setting, with a low-profile so that it would be invisible over the front parapet wall.
